## FEATURED SPEAKER

*John H. Sununu*



**JOHN H. SUNUNU**, of Hampton Falls, New Hampshire, is currently President of JHS Associates, Ltd. and former partner of Trinity International Partners, a private financial firm. He has a storied background as an educator, engineer, small businessman, and community and international leader.

Governor Sununu became New Hampshire's 75th Chief Executive on January 6, 1983, serving three consecutive terms. On January 21, 1989, he was commissioned Chief of Staff to the President of the United States and served in the White House until March 1, 1992, overseeing daily operations of the White House and serving as counselor to the President. After his departure from public service, Governor Sununu co-hosted CNN's nightly "Crossfire" program (1992-1998), a news/public affairs discussion program, winning a Cable Ace Award in 1994.

Governor Sununu has a long tenure in academia, attending Massachusetts Institute of Technology at both the undergraduate and graduate levels, earning his Ph.D. in 1966 in Mechanical Engineering. From 1968 until 1973 he was Associate Dean of the College of Engineering at Tufts University and Associate Professor of Mechanical Engineering. He served on the Advisory Board of the Technology and Policy Program at MIT from 1984 until 1989. He has served as a board member of MIT's Nuclear Fuel Cycle Study Board and the Energy Innovation Project Board. He is a member of the National Academy of Engineering. He was a Visiting Professor of Practice in Public Service at Harvard Kennedy School of Government from 2003-2004. In 2015 he authored "The Quiet Man: The Indispensable Presidency of George H. W. Bush."

During 2011-2012, Governor Sununu served as Chairman of the Romney for President National Steering Committee, as well as a prominent surrogate spokesperson for the campaign.

The governor is married to the former Nancy Hayes. They have eight children and sixteen grandchildren.
